About Me as Manager of The Orchard

In my role as Manager of The Orchard I am committed to ensuring that young people have the best experience they can whilst living with us and reach their full potential towards their transition into adulthood. As a team at The Orchard, we utilise the knowledge, professional skills and experience to ensure we are effectively supporting the young people in our care. I have worked in the industry for 7 years with young people and adults with LD, autism and ADHD. I have a Level 3 diploma in Health and Social Care and a BA Hons in Childhood and Youth Studies. During college I also studied psychology and completed a level 2 in counselling skills. I am currently undertaking my level 5 in Leadership and Management.



About The Orchard

The Orchard lies on the East Lancs in Windle, St Helens, in what is Ormskirk's premier residential location. The house is located in a semi-rural area, which is a small village within the town of St Helens. The Orchard cares for young people, who have a range of conditions most notably Autism Spectrum Condition, Learning difficulties, and Social, Emotional and Mental Health. As every child is unique, we will always assess children individually.

The culture that we create and uphold in the home is delivered through proactive, positive behaviour support using nurturing and supportive practices to ensure that young people are happy living in the home and have fulfilled lives. We cater for up to three young people both boys and girls of varying ages up to the age of 18 years.

The home is a large, detached property, young people each have their own large bedrooms and a shared bathroom, with one additional toilet in the home. The home has communal areas for all young people, with plenty of space for different indoor activities, including a games room, a private large rear garden in which the young people can relax and enjoy outdoor activity. The gardens have a trampoline, swimming pool, garden games and a seating area. The home ensures that young people are supported in all areas of their lives, including access to activities and hobbies, that staff support to ensure that young people have the same opportunities as all other young people.

We have established a professional staff team who are suitably qualified, experienced, trained, and able to support up to four young people, with the aforementioned conditions, with their individual needs.



The Orchard operates a multi team approach to matching young people, with input from the My3 Therapies team and Manager. We have strong professional relationships with external agencies to ensure we can meet the needs of the young people in placement.

The current cohort of young people is 14-16 year olds, with a mix of male and female and have diagnosis of autism ADHD and related conditions. Matching to these young people would be suitable for a child/young person with Autism or related conditions i.e., ADHD, social and emotional difficulties.
